Resurfacing of I-77 in Huntersville Will Begin This Friday
Traffic Shifts in Place for Next Six Weeks

Charlotte, N.C. (October 16, 2017) – Traffic shifts on I-77 will take place between Exit 23 and Exit 25 in Huntersville as crews working on the I-77 Express Lanes project begin resurfacing the general purpose lanes between Exit 23 and Exit 25. Traffic will be shifted to the median lanes of I-77 in both northbound and southbound directions. Traffic shift operations will occur overnight on Friday, October 20 for the southbound lanes, and Saturday, October 27 for the northbound lanes from 10:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m., weather permitting. These traffic shifts will be in place for approximately six weeks.

Motorists are encouraged to pay attention when approaching the work zone, obey the posted speed limit and work zone signs, and allow extra time to reach their destinations safely.

Once the project is complete, dedicated express lanes will run adjacent to the existing general purpose lanes. The number of general purpose lanes will remain the same as today. Drivers will have the choice of using the express lanes to avoid travel delays, the general purpose lanes or a combination of both. Vehicles with three or more occupants (including the driver) and equipped with a transponder may use the express lanes for free. The full 26-mile project is slated to be completed in 2018.
