Detour Planned Overnight on I-277/Brookshire Freeway for Construction of New Bridge

Charlotte, N.C. (January 14, 2019) – A detour on I-277 westbound will be in place beginning Monday, January 14, through Wednesday, January 16, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. as crews continue constructing the new bridge that will connect motorists to I-77 Express from I-277/Brookshire Freeway to I-77 northbound. All traffic moving westbound on I-277 will be detoured onto Exit 5A (77 North) to Exit 13B (85 South) and then continue to Exit 36 (Brookshire Boulevard).

The detour is as follows:

I-277 Westbound

Monday, January 14, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday, January 15, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Wednesday, January 16, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.

***Detours are subject to weather conditions and major special events in the area.

Motorists are encouraged to pay attention when approaching the work zone, obey the posted speed limit and work zone signs, and allow extra time to reach their destinations safely.

Once the project is complete, dedicated express lanes will run adjacent to the existing general purpose lanes. The number of general purpose lanes will remain the same as today. Drivers will have the choice of using the express lanes to avoid travel delays, the general purpose lanes or a combination of both. Vehicles with three or more occupants (including the driver) and equipped with a transponder may use the express lanes for free.
