**PAVING TO OCCUR ON I-77 BETWEEN UPTOWN CHARLOTTE AND CORNELIUS THIS WEEKEND**

**Charlotte, N.C. (November 1, 2019)** – Construction crews will be conducting paving operations in several locations on I-77 between I-277 in uptown Charlotte and Catawba Avenue (Exit 28) in Cornelius this weekend. This work will occur during the daytime and nighttime hours.

I-77 Southbound (beginning at 11 p.m. Friday to 9 a.m. Sunday)

Traffic will be shifted from the general purpose lanes into the express lanes just north of Catawba Avenue (Exit 28). Traffic can then exit the express lanes between Sam Furr Road (Exit 25) and Gilead Road (Exit 23). No tolls will occur in this section during this detour. Drivers who choose to stay in the express lanes after the exit point will be charged. The express lane entrance north of Exit 31 Langtree Road in Mooresville will also be closed for safety during this traffic shift.

The exit ramp to I-77 southbound from Catawba Avenue (Exit 28) will experience intermittent closures.

Paving will also occur between Lakeview Road and Cindy Lane on I-77 Southbound in Charlotte. Drivers will be shifted into the express lanes in this section. The entrance and exit ramps to/from Sunset Road will be closed for paving also.

I-77 Northbound (beginning 9 a.m. Sunday)

Expect intermittent closures of the on ramp from I-485 to I-77 Northbound as crews will be paving in this location. The right general purpose lane between WT Harris Boulevard and I-485 will be closed during this time.
