PAVING TO OCCUR DURING THE DAYTIME IN I-77 EXPRESS CORRIDOR

Charlotte, N.C. (December 2, 2020) – Construction crews will be conducting paving operations during the day beginning Thursday, December 3 through Sunday, December 6 between uptown Charlotte and Mooresville.

The daytime paving schedule and locations are as follows:

Thursday, December 3 and Friday, December 4

- The express lanes will be closed on I-77 Southbound in Charlotte at the entry point just north of I-85. The direct connector from I-85 Southbound to I-77 Southbound will remain open along with the direct connector from I-277.
- The express lanes on I-77 Southbound will be closed from the entry point between Exits 33 and 31 in Mooresville to just north of Exit 28 in Cornelius.

Saturday, December 5 and Sunday, December 6 (none of these closures will happen concurrently)

- The left lane on I-277 Outer approaching I-77 in Charlotte will be closed. The Exit 5C ramp to I-77 Southbound will also be closed.
- Exit 5B I-277 direct connector to the express lanes on I-77 Northbound will be closed.
- The right two lanes of I-77 Northbound will be closed between I-277 and Exit 12 LaSalle Street.
